Nitty Gritty

1. Submissions must be **previously unpublished**, online or in print, including on personal websites.
2. Work must be a maximum of **7500 characters, including spaces** (approximately 1750 words). For formatting poetry, keep in mind that the story dispensers print on paper that can hold only 40 characters per line.
3. Comics, sketches, and drawings will be printed in grayscale.
4. **Final submissions are due May 10th, 2023.**

Your stories could be part of the collection "Science on the Move" published through StoryCube dispensers, portable printers from global publisher Short Édition, offering stories at the push of a button.
